



## Safety Rules and Equipment Troubleshooting

It is the responsibility of the customer to ensure that all possible precautions are taken to avoid injury to people or damage to the inflatable. Please ensure that the following safety instructions are followed.

- **SUPERVISION by a qualified and responsible adult is required at all times**
- Follow all instructions on equipment
- REMOVE shoes, eyeglasses and any sharp objects
- No open flames or smoking in or near any inflatable unit(s)
- NO pets, food, drinks, gum, or silly string
- No BBQ grills or fireworks near inflatable
- No sand in or around the equipment
- In the event of inclement weather or wind beyond 20 MPH, it is the customers responsibility to have jumpers exit the inflatable, unplug the unit, and bring motor in out of any rain.
- Blowers must be kept dry at all times
- Somersaults, diving, wrestling, rough play and flips are prohibited
- DO NOT allow children to jump onto or off the unit(s)
- When renting a slide, children should go down the slide FEET FIRST ONLY, one rider at a time for each lane.
- EXIT immediately if the unit begins to lose air.
- In the event of high winds or storms, all participants need to exit the unit and unplug the motor and extension cord from the power outlet.
- Only persons of the same size or age group should use the unit(s) at any given time, no adults and children, or larger children with small children at the same time.
- All Inflatables should be securely anchored and fully inflated before any riders are allowed to enter.
- Do not install inflatables near a pool.
- Under no circumstances is climbing on the exterior of the inflatable allowed
- Check anchors regularly during play to ensure they remain securely in the ground when using outdoors.
- Units found to be dirty beyond reasonable use will result in a \$250 cleaning fee.

- Water slide rentals: Turn off water hose prior to deflating the slide. Failure to do so will flood the inside of the unit resulting in a \$200 drying fee.

### **Equipment Troubleshooting**

Should any equipment develop a problem, or does not function correctly at any time, or customer does not understand the operating instructions, customer agrees to immediately cease use of that equipment. In particular, if the inflatable unit begins to deflate, customers will immediately have riders exit the unit, and then check for one of the following conditions:

1. The blower has stopped. In which case check the power cord connection at the outlet where the unit plugs in to make sure it has not been unplugged.
2. If blower continues to run, check for blockage in the air intake screen on the side of the blower unit. Also check both air tubes on the back of the unit for snugness and tighten the ties if necessary.
3. If either of these steps corrects the problem, fully inflate the unit prior to permitting anyone to use the unit.

Customer agrees to follow all safety rules listed here as well as those on the unit and accepts full responsibility for all damages from the time the unit is delivered, until the unit is picked up by Bounce-N-Party.
